

Note to Bidders:

1. Special Note:

In view of the latest guidelines issued by Government of India offers in INR shall only be considered for this irrespective of anything indicated contrary to at any place in the NIT documents. Hence terms and conditions relevant to offers in FE shall not be applicable for this tender.

2. Income Tax or any other tax will be deducted at source wherever applicable as per the provisions of corresponding Income Tax Act or the relevant GST Act of any other statute.
3. Post supply inspection in respect of supplies made is not permitted. Any offer containing the condition of post supply inspection will be out-rightly rejected. It is therefore, mandatory for the bidders, while quoting, to indicate in clear terms the requirement of post supply inspection by any outside agency.
4. The firm/supplier who is registered with MSME as "SERVICE" is not exempted from EMD submission against the tender enquiry for supply of items/material and in such case EMD has to be submitted.
5. In case of submission of Demand Draft (D.D.) for EMD/ Security Deposit etc. the following points should be ensured.
 - A) The Demand Draft (D.D.) should be strictly as per the current guidelines of Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
 - B) The name of firms should be mentioned in the Demand Draft.
 - C) Signature of two authorizes of issuing bank should be on the demand draft, in case the amount of Demand Draft for Rs. 1.5 lakhs or more.
