

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1) The tendered item is reserved to be procured from MSE vendors. Hence offers received only from MSE's registered vendors (under manufacturers category) will be first considered for evaluation. However, if the items offered by MSE registered firms are not meeting the technical specifications the same will be procured from other sources.

2) "As per the Public Procurement Policy for Micro And Small Enterprises (MSEs), Government of India, only registered MSMEs (category-manufacturer/ producer) are eligible for supply of items reserved for SSI Units including Handicraft Sector. In order to claim any privilege under MSME Act for such products, the bidders are advised to submit a copy of valid certificate failing which the offer will be considered as non-MSE offer. No further correspondence will be entertained in the matter. Please note that the provision of the Policy are applicable only for the 'goods produced' and 'services rendered' by MSEs."

3) All the vendors registered under MSE are to provide a declaration that they have registered their Udyog Aadhar Memorandum Number (UAM) on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) failing which they cannot avail the benefit available to MSEs as contained in the Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order 2012 issued by MSME.
